PRAYER TOPICS FOR THURSDAY 29th JULY, 2010 – SCRIPTURE READING **1 JOHN 4:1-**

THURSDAY – PRAYER FOR THE CHURCH

1. Pray that every member of the church and their respective families would be divinely protected and preserved especially during times of natural disaster. Psa. 31:1-3
 2. Pray for a spiritual re-awakening and revival in the life of every member of the church. Eph. 1:15-19, 3:14-19, Phi. 1:9-11, Job 10:12
 3. Pray and destroy every form of satanic attack Isa. 54:14-17
 4. Pray for divine favour upon the lives, marriages, businesses of church members. Dan. 10:12-14, Isa 15:27. Pray against the spirit of Adultery, Fornication, barrenness
 5. Deal with every yoke of poverty over your life. 3 John 2
 6. Call on the blood Jesus Christ to speak on your behalf and overrule the voice and demand of the accuser. Hebrews 12:24
 7. Pray that God would create conditions and right circumstances to bring to pass His plans and purpose for your life.
 8. Pray and abort any strategy from hell to discredit the entire leadership of the church
 9. Decree Irrecoverable confusion into the camp of the enemy.
 10. Subject and superimpose the voice of the blood of Jesus Christ over the voice of the accuser.
 11. Pray against witchcraft projection to manipulate and weaken the effectiveness of the leaders of the church.
 12. Raise a standard in prayer against any invasion of hell into the life and family of the rank and file of the church.
- Pray that God will open your eyes and grant you a revelation of him. (**Ephesians 1:17-19; Revelation 3:14-18**). Pray this day that you will have an encounter with God (**John 14:21**)
 - Pray that you will experience the Holy Spirit. Ask the Lord to fill you with the Holy Spirit and cause you to walk and operate in the Gifts and Power of the Holy Spirit. (**John 14:26; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:4; Acts 2:17; I Corinthians 12:3-11**)
 - Pray that God will reveal his prophetic timing and purpose for your life to you. (**Galatians 1:15-16**)
